No Pay, No Play Policy

During our 2008 Fall Soccer season, we suffered a significant financial hurt due to unpaid registration fees. 66 players had not paid by the end of the season (leaving us with an approximate \$4,000 deficit). That number has been reduced to 22 unpaid players thanks to efforts made by coaches to collect fees after the season. In an effort to eliminate outstanding registration fees, we have implemented a payment policy for the 2009 season.

If you are not able to pay the day you register your child(ren), you are required to sign an agreement that you will pay before the season starts. The "No Pay, No Play" Policy will be in effect for 2009 and will strictly be enforced by all coaches.

We will make every effort to accommodate payment options if necessary; however, all payments must be made in full by the first season game, which is September 12, 2009. With signups starting as early as April, we hope that the September 12 deadline is achievable.

I _____ am aware that if all outstanding registration fees for my child/children are not paid by 9/12/09, my son(s)/daughter(s) will not be eligible to participate in soccer games until they are paid.
